
Non-Residential Rain Sensor Rebate Application

Follow these steps to earn your rebate:

1. Verify that you qualify for a Centennial Water and Sanitation District rebate:
 You receive your water bill from Highlands Ranch Metropolitan District
2. Purchase a qualifying rain sensor which stops the irrigation cycle once ¼" or less of rain has been received.
3. Complete this application and submit to Centennial Water **within 90 days of the purchase date**.
4. Include the following materials:
 Signed affidavit with a copy of your photo identification.
 Original receipt, which must include the date, rain sensor brand, and rain sensor model number in order to qualify.

Rebate Amount

- \$50 per rain sensor or cost of rain sensor excluding tax and labor, whichever is less.

Program Requirements and Information

- Program applies to Highlands Ranch Metro District, Centennial Water and Sanitation District and Northern Douglas County Water and Sanitation District customers only. Account must be in good standing.
- All applicants must include: completed application, completed affidavit showing proof of lawful presence in the U.S. and the original dated receipt with make and model from the package.
- Application must be received no later than 90 days from the date of purchase.
- The rebate cannot exceed \$50 per rain sensor. Multiple rain sensors will be subject to approval by Centennial's Water Conservation Coordinator.
- An inspection may be required to verify the installation and operation of your rain sensor(s).
- Rebate program is first come, first served. Limited funds are dedicated for the program each year. When the funds are exhausted, the program will end.

Under House Bill 06S-1023, anyone 18 years of age or older must prove lawful presence in the United States to receive public benefits.

- Valid Colorado driver's license or one of the following states deemed eligible by the Colorado Department of Revenue:
 - AL, AZ, AR, CA, CT, DE, DC, FL, GA, ID, IN, IA, KS, KY, LA, ME, MN, MS, MO, MT, NV, NH, NJ, NY, ND, OH, OK, PA, RI, SC, SD, VA, WV, or WY
- Valid Colorado identification card
- United States Passport (except "limited" – issued for 5 years or less)
- United States military card
- United States military dependent's identification card
- United States Coast Guard Merchant Mariner card
- Native American tribal document
- Naturalization or citizenship certificate
- An I-94 immigration form with refugee or asylum status
- An unexpired resident alien card, permanent resident card, temporary resident card, or employment authorization card

Please mail a photocopy of your identification (in one of the forms listed above) and your signed affidavit along with the other rebate paperwork. ***We assure you that this information will remain confidential. You may remove/darken all sensitive information such as driver's license numbers or social security numbers from the copy of your ID that you submit to Centennial Water and Sanitation District.***

AFFIDAVIT

I, _____ (print name legibly), swear or affirm under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of Colorado that (check one)

I am a United States citizen, or

I am not a United States citizen, but I am a Permanent Resident of the United States, or

I am not a United States citizen, but I am lawfully present in the United States pursuant to Federal law.

I understand that this sworn statement is required by law because I have applied for a public benefit. I understand that state law requires me to provide proof that I am lawfully present in the United States prior to receipt of this public benefit. I further acknowledge that making a false, fictitious, or fraudulent statement or representation in this sworn affidavit is punishable under the criminal laws of Colorado as perjury in the second degree under Colorado Revised Statute 18-8-503 and it shall constitute a separate criminal offense each time a public benefit is fraudulently received.
