Executive Session

• Pursuant to Section 24-6-402(4)(b), C.R.S. for the purpose of conferring with legal counsel regarding Marcy Gulch Wastewater Treatment Plant construction contract matters.

The board did not go into executive session. Instead, attorney Flynn provided an update informing the board that staff has previously assessed liquidated damages for milestone 1 in the amount of \$602,500 and liquidated damages for milestone 2 in the amount of \$667,500 on the Marcy Gulch WWTP project general contractor. Staff and district attorneys have diligently been trying to negotiate a dispute resolution process with the general contractor, who has been unresponsive. Staff, based upon advice from legal counsel, intends to initiate collection of liquidated damages beginning with this month's pay application, if the general contractor continues to be unresponsive on the dispute resolution process.
