2. Water

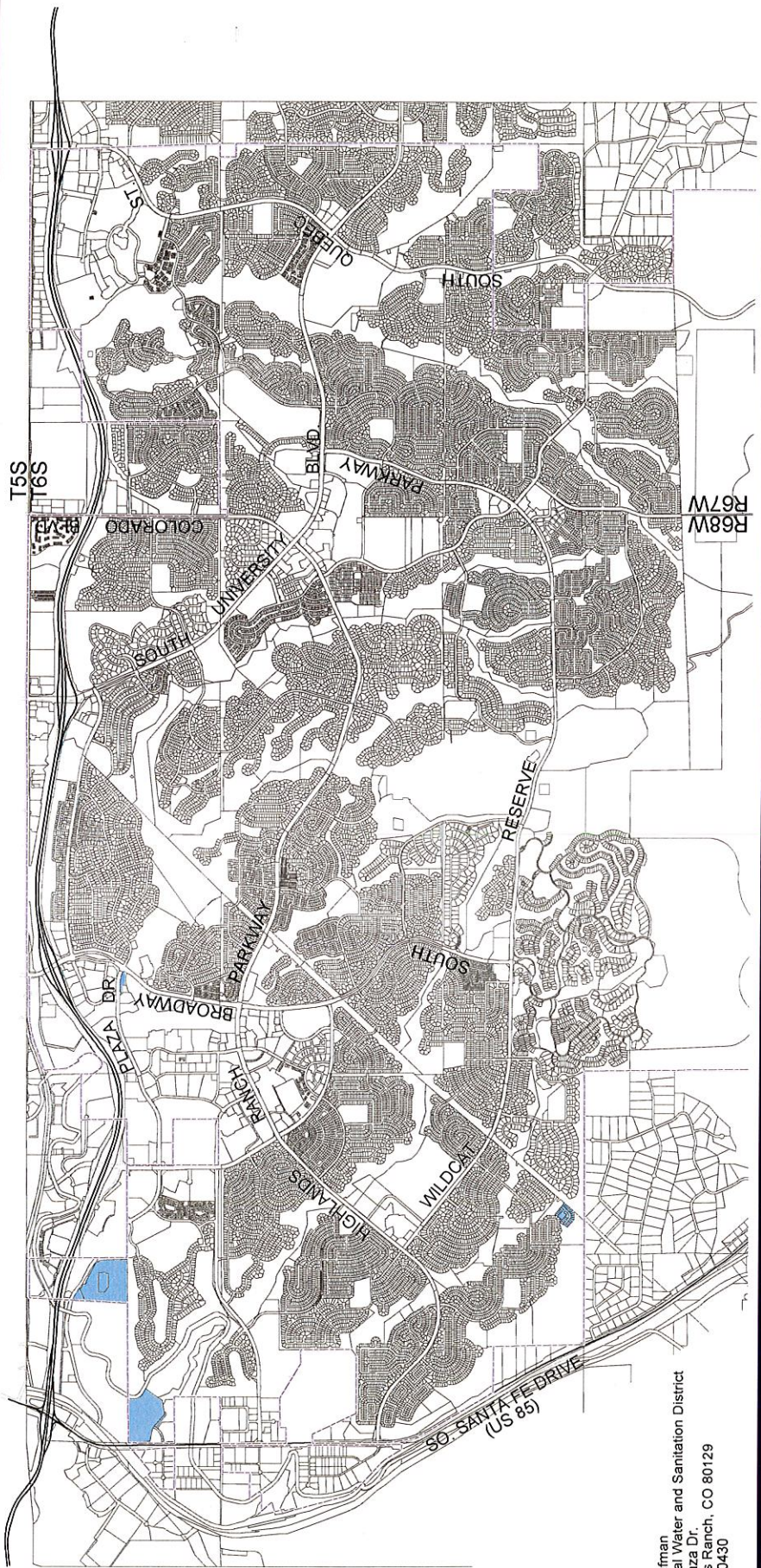
The District's service plan is attached to the Order Approving the Service Plan for of Centennial Water and Sanitation District approved by the District Court in Civil Action 1980CV00123 and which is recorded at reception number #337036 of records of Clerk and Recorder of Douglas County. This service plan, which can be revised from time to time, includes a description of the District's powers and authority, and a copy of the service plan is available from the Division.

Centennial Water and Sanitation District is authorized by Title 32 of the Colorado Revised Statutes to use a number of methods to raise revenues for capital needs and general operations costs. These methods, subject to the limitations imposed by section 20 of article X of the Colorado constitution, include issuing debt, levying taxes, and imposing fees and charges. Information concerning directors, management, meetings, elections and current taxes are provided annually in the Notice to Electors described in section 32-1-809(1), Colorado Revised Statutes, which can be found at the district office, on the district's web site, on file at the division of local government in the state department of local affairs or on file at the office of the clerk and recorder of each county in which the special district is located.

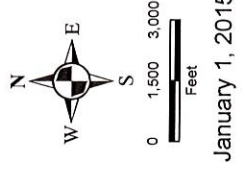
A map of the current boundaries of the District is attached hereto.
